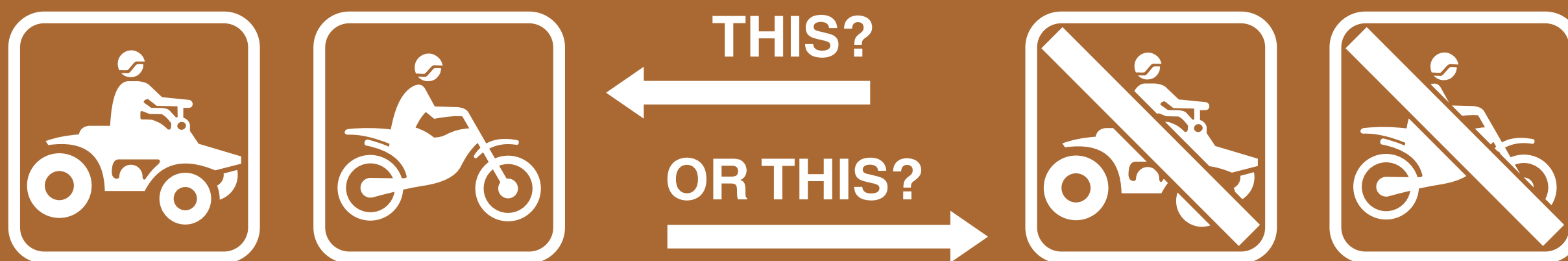


DIRT ALERT



IT DEPENDS ON YOU!

RESPECT is the Key to Keeping Your Privilege to Ride on Public Land.

RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

- Stay on established trails.
- Minimize erosion - avoid excessive wheelspin in sensitive areas.
- Remove your trash and litter.

RESPECT FOR OTHERS

- Be courteous to all trail users - slow down or stop when meeting others.
- Keep your machine quiet - less sound = more ground.
- Be kind to animals - don't harass or chase them.
- Do your part to create a positive image for ATV riders.
- Be as unobtrusive as possible in campgrounds - campgrounds are quiet places, not ATV playgrounds.
- Watch your speed - always use hand signals.
- Make sure the person behind you is always there - no one left behind.

RESPECT FOR YOURSELF

- Ride within your limits - safely and under control.
- Wear proper protective gear - helmet, boots, gloves, etc.
- Alcohol and riding do not mix - riding an ATV after consuming alcohol is dangerous to yourself and others.

RESPECT FOR PROPERTY

- Obey all posted closed and no trespassing signs.
- Know your riding area and its property boundaries.

RESPECT FOR AUTHORITY

- Share the road - keep right.
- Watch for vehicles when traveling on any road.
